**Falcon Club Meeting Minutes from August 3, 2022**

DeAndre James called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Welcome Reflection:** DeAndre gave a reflection on Community. Community is family. The new principal, Sarah Gialdini, was introduced. Heidi Denger was in attendance representing the Parent Club. Self introductions were given around the room.

**Minutes from May 11, 2022:** Linda Benko made a motion to approve the May minutes. The motion was seconded by Heidi Reynolds. The minutes were approved by all.

**Treasurer's Report:** Chrissie reported the total income of \$225K. FC expenses are \$117K and team expenses are \$125K. This puts us at a negative \$17K.

Some reasons for the deficit are the golf tournament netted approximately \$12K rather than the \$25K we have made in the past. It is time to find a new venue for the golf tournament that does not cost us so much to hold our event. De La Veaga has changed their requirements, which costs more money and does not allow us to have as much of the income. Also, a lack of participation donations has caused our income to be smaller. Perhaps we should collect a lesser amount from parents whose kids play multiple sports to encourage the donation to be made. There is an increase in the number of students signing up to play sports.

Solutions to the problem were suggested, such as a \$75.00 Falcon Club membership would provide 2 tickets to home games and a \$150 membership would provide 4 tickets to home games. Charging gate fees for all home sporting events and encouraging more community attendance to games. The snack bar could be opened up at all home events, run by students and parents. Students could earn community service hours as well as receiving small business training.

**Athletic Director Update:** Louie reported that the number of kids signing up for sports has been great so far this year. Students are excited to play and happy to to be on campus and getting started
