Falcon Club Meeting Minutes from May 10, 2023

**Minutes fromApr. 13, 2023:** Louie Walters made a motion to approve the April minutes. The motion was seconded by Chrissie Reynolds. The minutes were approved by all.

**Drive 4 Schools:** Lorraine has this fundraiser once again this year. Grand prize will be 25,000\$, many other prizes as well. Fall sports teams will get tickets automatically. We would like to see more community involvement this year. Might pose this question, "If you don't give your \$200 participation donation, where do you think that money will come from?"

**Treasurer's Report:** Currently: \$198,740 in the bank, \$83,997 is the team balance figure. We are working on the remaining expenses for this school year. Stipends invoice should be in from district in about a month. It is looking like we will be in the black at the end of this year, or at least break

even, after 2 years of losses. Chrissie is resigning her position as treasurer effective June 30, 2023.

Athletic Director's Report: The school year is coming to an end. Beside the rain and make ups, the year went smoothly. Beach Volleyball won their league, boys volleyball came in 3 place. Beach Volleyball courts were bid here on campus, but bid was too expensive. Louie will look into additional bids.

**President's Report:** We attended the SVUSD meeting where more funds were requested for Falcon Club. More support was requested for coach's stipends and other expenses.

Discussions are ongoing with SVEF for more involvement on their part in assisting Falcon Club with fundraising efforts.

These are two possibilities of getting some extra help.

**Community:** DeAndre and Todd presented information about the Falcon Club on the My Scotts Valley podcast. They were hoping to get a broader message out about the Falcon Club, what we do and how we do it and why community support is needed. There will be a parcel tax measure on the ballet in 2023, and a bond measure in 2024. The passing of these two measures is important for the future of not just the Falcon Club, but all of our schools.
