3. Check with local businesses to see if they would be interested in participating in a kick back shopping day for the Falcon Club. A percentage of proceeds from the day's sales would go to Falcon Club.

4. Parents Night Out - Social gathering. Sell tickets. Live music. Perhaps Bruno's for the venue? Perhaps Valentine's Day for the event?
5. Movie Night - Bring in one of those inflatable screens. Sell tickets to see movie. Sell popcorn and snacks at event.

**Membership:** Memberships are still trickling in.

**Drive for Schools:** Next Friday will be the last day to pick up tickets. \$28,225 has been brought in, \$32,925 is pledged.
