Falcon Club Meeting Minutes from Feb. 2, 2022

Attendees: Louie Walters, Todd Hoffman, Chrissie Reynolds, Nancy Franich, Heidi Reynolds, Corbett Wright, Patti Erickson, Linda Benko, Tim Emmanuelson, Lorraine Strassman and Cherri Brownfield

Todd Hoffman started the meeting at 7:07 p.m.

Minutes from Feb. 2, 2022: Chrissie Reynolds made a motion to approve the December minutes. The motion was seconded by Cherri Brownfield. The minutes were approved by all.

Athletic Director Update: Louie began a discussion about phasing the SVSC project. We would like to look into doing the lights first. There would be four light poles. One on each 20 yard line of the football field. They would be "portable" and could be moved later if the permanent lights are ever put in. Louie has been talking with Musco and Boss, two companies that could supply the lights. These lights would not need DSA approval. We should check with the school board prior to installing the lights to see if they would be willing to fight a law suit just in case there was a legal complaint about the lights.

Nancy Franich made a motion to move forward with the plan to purchase the lights for the field. The motion was seconded by Heidi Reynolds. The motion was approved.

A conversation ensued about the history of the project and why it is at a stand still. Corbett explained that a large part of the funding was to come from the school district after a bond was passed, but the bond failed. Perhaps it is time for a new bond measure. The plans for the project have expired and would have to be brought up to code and resubmitted to DSA for approval.

There is currently approximately 450K at Edward Jones and an additional 20K that are the SVSC funds. The SVSC subcommittee is in support of using existing funds to purchase the lighting for the SVHS field as long as the school district will cover any threat of a law suit.

Treasurer's Report:

Chrissie Reynolds presented the overall balance of \$190,252 and the team balance of \$69,848. Expenses will leave the balance at about \$10,000. We are looking forward to the golf tournament and will see what that brings in.

Drive for Schools: It was decided that Falcon Club would continue to be the sole recipient of this fundraiser.
