Otherwise, our athletes are performing very well as this school year nears an end.

Hall of Fame: The idea was brought up to look for a sponsor for the event. We would like to make it a little more upscale event. We want to make these athletes and alumni feel honored. Nancy will look into a couple of nice venues for this event scheduled for Oct. 5 which is the day after Homecoming.

Fundraisers: Drive 4 Schools: It was a difficult system last fall. People paid for their tickets online, but Lorraine was not able to know who those people were. If we do this again, system needs to change.
