\$20,000 net for Golf Tournament; great turnout and all went well; 111 players; last year had 15 more golfers.

Balance of \$65,000 with remaining 2 seasons of coaches' stipends to pay out so will likely clear that out. Louie will pay out coaches at the end of May.

\$174,009 in main checking account and of that, teams own \$65,114. Chrissie indicates that Falcon Club should break even this year.

Physicals typically bring in about \$3,000 to \$5,000 for the Falcon Club.
