Treasurer's Report:

Chrissie Reynolds presented the overall balance of \$191,580 and the team balance of \$72,193.

The balance in the SVSC funds is approximately \$450,000 cash with \$300,000 more pledged. There are some SVSC expenses to start coming in which means the funds will start going out.

Louie Walters is having discussions with Tanya at the district office regarding the installation of the planned lights for the field. It was discussed that lighting will be necessary for the 2022-2023 school year as a later schedule is planned for classes and after school practices.

Nancy Franich will bring a copy of the SVSC plans for the stadium project to the next meeting in January. John Franich will review them and give a recommendation as to how phasing of the project might work and what part of the project can begin first.

Athletic Director Update:

Drive for Schools: There was a discussion regarding an email that Lorraine Strassman sent out. She suggested an idea to add the art, library, drama and Parent Club to the recipients of the Drive For Schools fundraiser. No decision was made on this at this meeting.
